The Village of Fall River offers two options for disposing of yard waste and brush: items may be left curbside for weekly collection by Village DPW, or material may be delivered to the Yard Waste & Recycling Center on Church Street/Gruhn Road during designated hours. In addition to yard waste and brush, recyclables may be dropped off at the Yard Waste & Recycling Center during designated hours. Recyclables will continue to be picked up curbside bi-weekly with regular trash collection. *Please note that grass clippings are accepted at the Yard Waste & Recycling Center, but will not be picked up at the curb.*

## **Curbside collection**

Village DPW will collect yard waste each Monday. Typically, this service will be offered from April through November, but may vary depending on weather conditions. Pick-up may be delayed a day if a holiday falls on Monday or if DPW is unavailable.

Material must be placed curbside by 6am on collection day.

Acceptable items for curbside collection include: leaves, plant debris, garden waste, brush.

Items *not* acceptable for curbside collection include: grass clippings, limbs greater than four inches in diameter, tree stumps/root balls, landscape fabric, landscape timbers, lumber or other building materials, mulch, rocks, any other trash.

Brush/branches must be cut to a maximum six feet in length and bundled (does not need to be tied).

All items must be of manageable weight and size for one person to lift and load into a pickup truck.

Additional pick-ups may be added as necessary due to storm damage, etc.

## Yard Waste & Recycling Center

A resident sticker is required to use the Yard Waste & Recycling Center. Stickers are available at the Fall River Village Hall, 641 S. Main St., during regular business hours. There is a \$5 annual fee for each vehicle sticker.

Yard Waste & Recycling Center hours are April 1–Nov. 30: Wednesday from 3–7 pm and Saturday from 8 am–1 pm; Dec. 1–March 31: Saturday from 9–noon only (weather permitting).

Items accepted at the Yard Waste & Recycling Center include: leaves, plant debris, garden waste, brush, grass clippings. Recyclable materials including paper, cardboard, plastic, tin, and glass containers are also accepted at the site.

Items *not* accepted at the Yard Waste & Recycling Center include: limbs greater than eight inches in diameter, tree stumps/root balls, landscape fabric, landscape timbers, lumber or other building materials, mulch, rocks, any other trash.

All items must be unloaded in the proper designated areas. Materials may be left in paper/biodegradable bags– plastic bags or other containers must be emptied. Plastic bags may be disposed of on site.

The site attendant may assist with unloading, but is not required to do so.

The Yard Waste & Recycling Center is for use by Village of Fall River residents only and is not intended for use by commercial contractors.



The Fall River Yard Waste & Recycling Center is located approximately .4 miles east of the village on Church Street/Gruhn Road.

At the second sharp curve in the road, continue straight ahead on the gravel driveway.

## Items accepted for recycling at the Yard Waste & Recycling Center:

Aluminum– All types, clean, free of liquid

- Cardboard– Corrugated, non-wax, clean, flattened, remove any wax or plastic liners (Beer/soda cardboard packaging is not accepted.)
- Plastic bottles– #1 and #2 only, rinsed clean, caps removed (Plastic grocery/shopping bags are not accepted.)
- Glass– Bottles and jars only, rinsed clean, caps removed, colors can be mixed (Window glass, pottery, ceramics, dishes, and ovenware are not accepted.)
- Paper– Newspaper, magazines, office paper, junk mail

Tin– Food cans only, rinse clean
